Methodology

A judicious mix of lectures, cases discussions, experience sharing, simulations and role-playing shall form part of the methodology. The participants would develop an action-plan for implementation at the end of the programme.

Target Participants

Principals with 0-5 years experience in the 35-45 year age band and PGT having a minimum of 10 years of teaching experience and aspiring to become principals.

Programme Dates and Venues

The Programs shall be conducted at IIT Delhi, **between 23rd May 2011 and 18th June 2011**, with extensive post-class assignments/group work. The second week of the Program shall be conducted in a residential mode outside Delhi. There will be strict code of conduct as per the IIT Delhi norms. Selected applicants will have to pay for their travel, board, lodge for the personal interaction at IIT Delhi and those admitted to the programme thereafter will arrange for their travel, board, lodge during the programme at IIT Delhi and all other incidental costs associated with the programme.

Fees

The course fee which was ₹60000/- per participant has been entirely waived off for this batch and all the selected candidates will get 100% scholarship for the program.

The fee is underwritten by IYC World Soft- infrastructure www.iycworld.com. Hence, no fee is payable by the teachers selected for this programme. Participants are provided free the course materials, stationery and working lunch/tea/coffee during the breaks. Accommodation at the outstation location shall be arranged by the organizers and no additional cost is payable for the same. All other costs such as travel, board and lodge during the SLP will be personally borne by the selected applicants.

All the applicants invited for the personal interaction at Delhi as part of the selection process will also be required to take care of their travel, board and lodge costs for the same.
